## **Praying through Romans 8:1 (Sunday October 2)**

Thank You, dear Heavenly Father, that there is no condemnation in Christ. Give us Your grace to walk by Your Spirit. Thank You, in Jesus' precious name, AMEN.

“There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.” (Romans 8:1)

## **Praying through Romans 8:2 (Monday October 3)**

Heavenly Father, thank You for Your grace, which has set me free from the curse of the law and the power of sin in my life. Thank You for sending Christ Jesus whose death purchased my freedom from the power of sin and death. I pray that I may walk in spirit and truth as I submit to the Holy Spirit so that my old sinful nature is kept in the place of death. Help me to walk in spirit and truth and not to revert back to the law or engage in fleshly carnality, knowing that I have been set FREE and am enabled to stand fast in that liberty, as I submit to the leading of the Holy Spirit. In Jesus' name I pray, AMEN.

“For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.” (Romans 8:2)

## **Praying through Romans 8:3-4 (Tuesday October 4)**

Heavenly Father, I worship and praise and thank You for sending Your only Son to be our sin offering. Thank you that you fulfilled all the righteous requirements of the law so that we might have life in You. In Jesus' name, AMEN.

“For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering. And so He condemned sin in sinful man, in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit.” (Romans 8:3-4)

## **Praying through Romans 8:5-8 (Wednesday October 5)**

Loving Father, thank You for Your faithfulness, that even when I am faithless, You prove faithful. Help me to keep the eyes of my heart fixed on Jesus, and help me to develop a spiritual mind-set that honors You. Today I set my heart and mind on what Your Spirit desires. In Jesus' name I pray, AMEN.

“Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace; the sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God’s law, nor can it do so. Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God.” (Romans 8:5-8)

## **Praying through Romans 8:9 (Thursday October 6)**

Heavenly Father, thank You that in Christ, I have been born from above, given a new nature, and received the Holy Spirit as a guarantee of Your eternal promise to all those who trust in Christ for salvation. May I walk in newness of spirit and do only those things that are pleasing to You. This I ask in Jesus' name, AMEN.

“You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ.” (Romans 8:9)

## **Praying through Romans 8:10 (Friday October 7)**

Heavenly Father, thank You that I have been born again of the Spirit by faith and been made spiritually alive in Christ. Thank You that I have the Spirit of the resurrected Lord Jesus living in me. Thank You that although I live in a body of sin which is subject to physical death I will one day be clothed with an immortal body - by faith... in Christ Jesus... my God and Savior, in Whose name I pray, AMEN

“But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness.” (Romans 8:10)

## **Praying through Romans 8:11 (Saturday October 8)**

Heavenly Father, how I praise and thank You that the Spirit of Him who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead is living in me, and because He lives I too will receive His immortal life. Thank You that the One Who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to my mortal body through His Spirit who dwells in me. May I never lose the wonder of this truth, and I pray that I will never become complacent or lukewarm about my great salvation. Open the eyes of those who have been blinded by the god of this age and convict men and women of their need of a Savior - and use me in whatsoever way you choose. This I ask in Jesus' name, AMEN.

“And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.” (Romans 8:11)

## **Praying through Romans 8:12-14 (Sunday October 9)**

Loving Father, Your plan of salvation, by grace through faith, is wonderful. Your continuing plan of sanctification, by grace through faith, as we submit to the Holy Spirit, is truly awesome. Help me to be willing to submit to Your Holy Spirit and to be led by You always, maturing in the faith to Your praise and glory. ## **Praying through Romans 8:15 (Monday October 10)**

Thank You, Father, that You are my Abba Father and I am Your child. Thank You that I have Your indwelling Spirit of love, peace, joy, and hope in my heart. You are a faithful and gracious God. I bring before You those who are slaves to fear that I will encounter today. Open up to them Your grace that they may receive the Spirit of adoption and may know that You are a Good Heavenly Father. Thank You, Abba Father. In Jesus' name, AMEN.

“For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of son ship. And by Him we cry, “Abba, Father.” (Romans 8:15)

## **Praying through Romans 8:16 (Tuesday October 11)**

Loving Father, thank You for the indwelling Holy Spirit and His witness to us Your children. We want to abide in You and You in us so that Your Holy Spirit will have free access to teach us and to guide us into all truth including the promise that we are Your children. Sometimes, I feel I should do something to deserve Your favor, but that would not be grace. May I become so firmly grounded in the truth of Your Word and the glory that it reveals, that I can place the sufferings of this present time in their correct perspective.
