A Note from Pastor Kelly

The trip to great grandma and grandpa's was always an adventure. It was a gravel road, and you had to cross several cattle guards and was about a 60 mile drive. You would turn north at

Boone and take the Boone Road north till Truckton. Then back east about 2 miles. Although eastern Colorado is relatively flat, there are some rolling hills that dot the landscape.

Once you turn west on the Truckton road and make it the block through Truckton, you start going up and down the small rolling hills. I remember how exciting that was. You go up the hill and there in the distance on the left was the farm. "There it is!" we would exclaim. Then down the hill, wondering to ourselves how many hills there were. I could never remember. Then back up the hill shouting "There it is!" Except this time it was closer and we could make out more things like the house or the barn. Then down the hill again and no farm house. Then up again and we could see the Russian Olive trees lining the driveway and before you knew it, you could see the outhouse and just like that, we were at my dad's grandparents house.

I feel like Lent and Easter are a bit like that trip from our house to west of Truckton. Much of the time is spent in the valley. It is there that it is hard, if not impossible, to see the goal clearly: Easter, the resurrection, life eternal. Then once a week we gather in worship and get to shout "There it is!" We get to sing and worship and look to the cross and the empty tomb. But the rest of the weeks we travel in the valley. It is there we learn and grow, confess and repent, ever listening for the master's voice.

There was a rhythmic journey to George and Laura Sipes house. I got to take that trip one last time the summer before dad died. I once again got to feel the excitement of going up

and down looking intently for the house. And although the house is gone, the barn is gone and most of the Russian Olive trees are gone, the excitement of the journey did not disappoint. This time I was driving and dad was the passenger. But either way, it was a trip I would make again and again.

Lent is the journey we take over and over each year. We start with ashes on our foreheads and we end with "Christ the Lord is Risen Today." Don't miss any part of the journey. On Sunday's, join us for the top of the hill experiences as we praise and worship and fall down on our knees to honor God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. On the inbetween days, enjoy the journey of learning, growing, abiding, confessing, repenting, serving, witnessing. Yes, at times the valley is dark and it is hard to see the goal. But know this. Just because you are in the valley and can't see the farm house, that doesn't mean it is not there. You have to have faith when you cannot see. (Hebrews 11:1)
