Evangel, as we look back on this past year, it is a testimony of what Jesus has done. It is a way of saying "Let me tell you 'bout my Jesus." Oh yes, there are the big things that Anne listed in the song: "He makes a way where there ain't no way, Rises up from an empty grave, Ain't no sinner that He can't save." And we ought to sing and shout "Hallelujah" over and over and over when God is doing these things!

But let's keep remembering what we have seen God do at Evangel in recent years. First, he has done all the things listed in the song. Jesus did rise from the dead and we are witnesses and share in that resurrection ("For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his." Romans 6:5). Jesus showed us a way when there seemed to be no way. When we not only replaced the aging and worn out roof, but did so without going into debt. Through your amazing gifts and many years of the Trustees being good stewards of gifts given in the past, we have a brand new beautiful roof. We are poised and ready to share the Kingdom of God another 100 years in this wonderful building that God has given us. Add this to the recent success of joining the Global Methodist Church, and all of your generosity that went into that.

We all have sinned and fallen short of God's glory (Romans 3:23). And Jesus came to save us. One of the great lessons from this year was that we need to be in the business of multiplication. We learned that the harvest is plentiful and the workers are few. We have been praying that the Lord of the Harvest would provide workers.

It was at the end December of last year that Dave Jones learned that he was being ordained in 2026. God is raising up workers for the Harvest from our very own Church! I wonder who is next ...?

So, thank you for being part of what God is doing here at Evangel. The overall financial giving has been very generous, even if giving to the general fund was reduced somewhat due to giving to the roof project. (Remember, the weekly general fund giving supports Evangel's annual budget: staff compensation, administration expenses and ministry expenses. Maintenance on the church building is not a part of the general budget.) Evangel's budget is a tangible telling about what Jesus has done. So make sure you do: tell 'bout my (Your) Jesus. Tell through your giving, tell through your faithfulness, tell through your testimony, tell through worship, service and outreach.

Just tell 'bout Jesus. And, THANK YOU for doing so!





